Subject: A Spiritual Life Must Have Preference Over Everything:

If you want to be saved, your concern above everything should be to have a spiritual life. A spiritual life is a righteous and holy life. The spiritual life must begin in your mind, because everything that you do is governed by the thoughts that enter your mind. When you have holy and righteous thoughts, your deeds will be holy and righteous. All such ways of living are produced by the Holy Spirit that has given you the new-birth.

The new-birth, which is a spiritual birth, starts in your mind, and is followed by a new way of living, which will also be spiritual. A new spiritual mind will be connected with God to the extent that you will seek to obey His commandments, and do that which is right in His sight.

Subject: God Must Be A Part Of Your Daily Life:

When you are born again, the Holy Spirit brings God into your mind. If the members of a church assembly do not have God in their mind, neither is He in their assembly. If the preacher in the pulpit has his mind on women in the church for social pleasures, God is not in the preacher.

God is represented by His Spirit that chooses people to be His workmanship. People must carry God to an assembly by means of His Spirit. This means that they must be filled with the Holy Spirit, and living a sin-free life on a daily basis. After which they can go to an assembly and God will be there with them by means of His Spirit that has been a part of their daily lives. The people must be as holy in their daily lives as they are in their assembly to worship God.

Subject: The Light:

The church that the Holy Ghost establishes is supposed to require those who follow Christ to be true and faithful examples of all that Christ stood for. Prior to completing His job on earth, Christ instructed the church, or His disciples to be the

light of the world, and not to keep that light under a bushel, but on a candlestick so that it might give light to all that are in the house. This means that those who are saved should not confine themselves to their personal purposes in life. They should go forth into the community to help, assist, and be a light of righteousness to the unsaved world.

They should let their lights so shine before men that they might see their good works and glorify their Father, which is in heaven. People cannot find their way to God unless there is a light to lead them to God. Salvation for the sinner relies completely on the work that saved people do to bring them to Christ. People cannot find Christ except there be a guide to show them the way to Christ.

Those who have the light must be able to show a distinct contrast between the evils of the world and the righteousness of God. The light must be able to show evil and false religious teachings by comparing them with the true teachings of Christ, and what Christ has to offer in comparison to the failures of false religious teachings.

Subject: Few Are Chosen To Be Servants Of God:

When you start out with the Lord, you are going to be tried by the devil, but the reward that you will get if you overcome is worth any condition that you will have to suffer in order to hold your seat in the congregation of the righteous. The scriptures teach that eyes have not seen, ears have not heard, and it has not entered into the imagination of a man what wonderful things God has prepared for those who overcome (I Corinthians 2:9).

A saint should thank God that His Spirit moved them to accept salvation in the day that they heard His voice. Saints should thank God on a daily basis that His Spirit gave them the boldness to receive Jesus Christ into their lives. It takes the Holy Spirit to break away from sin and follow the Lord.

There are many who would like to live a life of righteousness, but the Spirit has not called them out from a world of sin. Many people may go to join a church, but few are chosen to be servants of the Lord. It is impossible to break away from a life of sin unless the Spirit of God helps you. Unless God helps a sinner, they will be without hope. Such sinners will die without hope, and without tasting the joy and peace that are given to those who are saved.

Nobody can break away from a life of sin unless the Holy Spirit helps them. They must be willing to surrender completely to the Holy Spirit with no intentions of retaining any sinful or worldly ways and be willing to die trying, and Christ will give them a new life. They must be willing to have their old life of sin crucified just as

Christ was crucified on Calvary. The Holy Ghost will help them using holy fire to consume their sinful nature.
