Subject: A Mobile Church:

In the last days, God is looking for those who are willing to be mobile churches. God is not interested in churches that sit on real estate, but he wants churches that can move around, and be verbal witnesses to the unsaved world. Churches that are constructed on real estate have not been able to save anybody; they are only good for shelter. Today God wants a living epistle, and not material churches that deceive people about where God is dwelling. II Corinthians 3: 2-3 reads as follows:

Verse 2 – Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:

God's mobile churches are people that carry the word of God written in their hearts, that the knowledge of God's word might be made known to the unsaved world.

Verse 3 – Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart.

Members of the true Church of God allow their lives to be programmed by the gospel of Jesus Christ. Their every operation is dictated by the Spirit of God. Such people are able to demonstrate the written gospel in life form. Such are living epistles demonstrating the life of Christ according to his gospel that the world may see, that though Jesus is in heaven, he is also alive in the saints on earth. Just having the gospel in literal form to quote scriptures, and preach in churches from pulpits as it is written in the Bible is death for all who are partakers of such a ministry. II Corinthians 3:6 reads as follows:

Verse 6 – Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.

To use the scriptures in word only is literal or the letter of the gospel and the letter killeth. You are spiritually dead when you do this. However, when you are able to live according to the gospel 24 hours a day doing what God instructs through

his word, then you would have become ministers of the Spirit of God, and the Spirit giveth life to all that are partakers.

Subject: Ambassadors For Christ:

When an ambassador goes to a foreign nation his purpose is not to represent the people of the nation from which he is sent, but he represents the president or the prime minister and their policy.

Many people of the nation from which an ambassador is sent, may have many different opinions and disagreements with the president or prime minister of their nation; therefore, the ambassador does not represent the opinions of all the people, but the policy of the one who sent him.

When God sends a preacher to stand before the people of the earth and declare the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the gospel that the preacher preaches may not be accepted or agreeable with the people who hear him, because he is not representing the people, but the one who sent him.

It is not practical to think that all the people of the earth would agree or accept the Gospel of Jesus Christ, because the gospel is not of this world, nor was it put together to represent the opinions of the people of the earth. Therefore, the people of the earth would find it difficult to agree or accept the Gospel of Jesus Christ, just as most Americans do not agree or accept the policies of foreign countries such as Russia, China, etc.

The Gospel of Jesus Christ represents the government of another kingdom that is altogether different from the governments and nations of the earth. So then, a true ambassador of the kingdom of heaven would most likely be rejected by those to whom he is presenting the foreign policy.

The government of the kingdom of heaven is superior in every way to the governments of the earth. Most people who have established careers and some sense of security here on earth are uncomfortable when they hear of another kingdom that far exceeds what their kingdom has to offer. On many occasions, they will take up the same repulsive spirit that the scribes and Pharisees took up when Jesus taught of a greater kingdom than what they were presently living in. So then, an ambassador does not preach to please the people, but the one whom he represents.

When a religious leader preaches to please his congregation, he is not sent by God, because he is seeking the glory of men. In the book of I Thessalonians 2:3-6, the Apostle Paul teaches as follows:

Verse 3 – For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile:

Verse 4 –	But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth our hearts.
Verse 5 –	For neither at any time used we flattering words, as ye know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God is witness:
Verse 6 –	Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor yet

of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ.

If a person desires to be able to accept the Gospel of Jesus Christ then such a person must be transformed from their way of thinking. This necessitates that they must repent of their ways, and struggle to accept the policy of the kingdom of heaven. When a person has repented and changed their way of thinking; then God will help them to be renewed in their minds. In doing this, such a person will receive proof that the policy of the kingdom of heaven is better than their ways of life on earth. Romans 12:2 reads as follows:

Verse 2 – And be not conformed to this world: (This means to reject the ways of this present world that are contrary to God's word.) but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Subject: Be Careful Of A Seducing Spirit After You Start To Walk With God:

If you accomplish anything in life, God will have to give the increase to that with which you are involved. Any accomplishment you make without God's involvement will not last. You may hear folk talk about God, giving God credit for what they have accomplished, but if Jesus is not in their way of life, their accomplishments will only be for a season. Whatever you are doing in life make sure sin is not a part of it, and keep Jesus up front in your life, though you experience low points in your endeavors, Jesus will always bring you up again. You will have to go down with Jesus if you want to rise with him.

To get anywhere with Jesus materially or spiritually you need a personal spiritual counselor. Jesus will assign you a spiritual counselor. Have confidence in the person that Jesus assigns you, and you will prosper spiritually as well as

materially or financially. When Jesus assigns you a spiritual counselor, the devil will use many people to discredit your spiritual counselor, and none of these people would be any profit to you. Ignore such people and follow your spiritual counselor and you will continue to prosper.

If you are not wise, the devil will make a fool out of you, causing you to follow foolish advice from people who have no God. Jesus had power to save all of the Jews, but the scribes and Pharisees, who had never done anything for anybody, were able to convince the people that Jesus was the devil and should be crucified. In spite of all the good works, healings and miracles Jesus had done for people, the scribes and Pharisees who had done nothing were able to convince the people otherwise. If you are not wise and knowledgeable of the devil's devices, he can send any religious hypocrite to make you believe that your assigned religious counselor, who has helped you to get out of sin and to prosper, is the wrong person to follow. Under such an influence of religious hypocrites, you would then become a religious fool.
