Subject: The Fruit Of The Holy Spirit Versus Corruptible Fruit:

If you know right from wrong, do you understand that Jesus came to give you power to live without doing wrong? Has your church taught you this? Does your church teach that the power of the Holy Spirit is given to you to keep you from doing wrong? If you make excuses for doing wrong, you do not have the Holy Spirit. You will only be able to get into the kingdom of heaven when you possess the Holy Spirit. You will only be able to get into the kingdom of heaven when you possess the Holy Spirit that disciplines your nature to commit sin. It does not matter how long you have been a Christian and how religious you are, you will not go to heaven unless you possess the Holy Spirit.

You will know the Holy Spirit by its fruit. Your life will consist of love, joy, meekness, longsuffering, peace, gentleness, goodness, faith, temperance and other godly virtues that you did not possess before you received the Holy Spirit. You cannot possess nor manifest the fruit of the Holy Spirit and sinful ways at the same time. If you are practicing sins, such as adultery, fornication, idolatry, lying, drinking liquor, smoking cigarettes, hatred, jealousy, wrath and any wicked ways, the fruit that you see and think is coming from the Holy Spirit is corruptible fruit. Though you may see some fruit in your life from time to time, if the fruit of your spirit is not consistent it is not good fruit, but corruptible fruit.

Good fruit of the Holy Spirit will not take a recess and allow sins to come forth and take control of your life, and later manifest itself. Good fruit of the Holy Spirit will always be the dominant virtues in your life, and your sins will be done away with.

Subject: The Prayer Of The Righteous:

Saved people are praying to God that he will extend a little more grace to the earth that others might be saved. Saved people stand between the sinner and God to prevent the wrath of God from falling upon the transgressors, until the offender has had a spiritual awakening. There will come a time when our work of this priesthood will cease to continue for those who are often reprov'd or corrected, who stiffens their necks and hardens their hearts. God warns that no matter how much you or I pray, who are saved, when he gets ready to destroy that person, he will do so because the individual knows better.

Saved people are a remnant chosen by God to present God to the world. We never would have had the knowledge of God if God had not made a choice of a man, that man being Abraham; and out of Abraham brought forth a seed, which represents the twelve tribes of Israel, and caused the spirit of that man to be injected into a people to worship him.

Saved people of today are the remnant, or a few that God has saved to be the leading people of righteousness in the world today. The reason that God only chooses a few unknown people is so that after he establishes his word and ways in these people, he will magnify them, and make them popular. The world would then be able to see God in these people.

If a people are already popular, and well known before God establishes his word and ways in them, he cannot use them unless they are willing to lose their fame and popularity like the Apostle Paul and Moses did. Not many people today that are famous would be willing to do this for the gospel's sake. Therefore, God chooses a people who are not known by the world to reveal himself in, so that he might be presented to the world.

God is represented in his people through the teaching of perfection. This will give them a distinction from all other religious groups and people, because not many religious groups believe that you can be perfect, even with God's help. Such groups deny the power of God. You will not find any other religious groups in the world that believe they can be perfect, except for the remnant that God saves. This is how you will be able to identify the true people of God. This was the first commandment that God gave Abraham. In Genesis 17:1, it teaches us:

Verse 1 – And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

This was one of the first commandments that Jesus gave us; in St. Matthew 5:48 it reads as follows:

Verse 48 – Be ye therefore perfect, even as your father which is in heaven is perfect.

So then, when God gives us a commandment to do something that we cannot do, it should be obvious that he is going to help us to do it. To say that nobody can be perfect is to contradict God if he commands us to be perfect. In II Timothy 3:5, it reads as follows:

Verse 5 – Having a form of godliness, but denying the power
Thereof: from such turn away.

For a Christian or other religious person to say that nobody can be perfect is to deny the power of God.

Subject: The Gospel Helps Your Conscience:

When you do wrong you have a conscience that will work against you, causing you to be mentally uncomfortable. Wrong deeds leave you at variance against yourself and God. There will be something in you that will cause you to be condemned when you do wrong. God has put a witness in you, which will work against your better frame of mind when you do wrong. Because there's not always sufficient help from your conscience, God sends the gospel to help you.

When your conscience condemns you and the word of God condemns you, you have two witnesses against you. Out of the mouth of two witnesses shall the truth be established.

Subject: Your Conscience Is Always In Touch With God:

When your conscience condemns you, it is because your conscience is in touch with God. When the word of God comes along and finds you, and condemns you, along with your conscience, although folks around you don't know what you have done, you and your conscience will realize that God knows.

Under these conditions, God is being revealed to you, but you must be alert to his reality. The word of God will give you instructions concerning his reality.
